



Rushmere St Andrew Neighbourhood Plan

Consultation period: Monday 11th April to 5pm Monday 6th June 2022

Rushmere St Andrew Parish Council has submitted their Neighbourhood Plan to East Suffolk Council ahead of it being submitted for independent examination. East Suffolk Council is publicising the plan and inviting representations, which will be forwarded to the examiner for consideration alongside the plan. Subject to the plan successfully completing all the relevant regulatory stages, the policies and proposals contained in the plan will be used by East Suffolk Council in the determination of planning applications within the Rushmere St Andrew Neighbourhood Area.

Any representations made may include a request to be notified of East Suffolk Council's decision whether to accept the Examiners' recommendation and future progress with the plan.

When must I submit my representation by?

Representations must be received no later than **5pm on Monday 6th June 2022**. All representations will be made available to view online as soon as possible after the close of the consultation.
